## WE HELP CHRISTIANS MOVE FROM CAMPUS TO THE WORKPLACE.

We recognise that the first year of work can be as exciting as it is daunting. Demands on time, energy and finances will change. It is important to think through how the Gospel shapes how we live after we leave the university campus. Welcome to Life@Work is all about equipping young workers for their life at work as followers of Jesus. We do this in two ways: Community and Training (pg 3).

### COMMUNITY

Young workers can often feel isolated in their first year of work life, Christian community and ministry looks different. Because of this, young workers can often feel disconnected and discouraged. We care for them by connecting them early with other Christians - those who are also starting work; and those who have been working for years. Our mission is to reach the world through the workplace with the good news of Jesus, and we believe that this is something we must do in fellowship with one another.

### TRAINING

We run events, provide Bible teaching and resources that help Christian young workers develop Gospel habits that will help them thrive and sustain them in the long run. This season of transition from campus to workplace can be confusing and we're here to help! Our hope is for young workers to continue growing in faith well beyond their first years of work; to live 'life that is truly life' (1 Timothy 6:19) in the workplace, for the good of others and the glory of God (pg 4).t in our workplaces looks different than it does on campus.
